

## Cow Pie Bingo Fundraiser

Experience the "sweet smell of success." A cow will turned loose on a fenced-in area which has been marked off into 64 squares. The cow determines the winner by making the first "deposit" on one of the squares. Chances on each square are sold for \$50. The winner receives 50% of the sales, Kids and adults will both love this fun event.

## Rules of the contest are:

- 1. Field will be divided into 64 equal squares.
- 2. Each square will be assigned a number.
- 3. Tickets are sold for \$50 each.
- 4. You must be 18 years old or older to purchase a square.
- 5. There is no limit to the number of squares that can be purchased by an individual.
- 6. The cow will be released onto the pen and will freely roam.
- 7. If the cow happens to drop its FIRST cow pie into your square, YOU WIN!!!
- 8. Winner is based off the cow's FIRST plop within the numbered field.
- 9. If the cow pie lands in one or more squares, the square that contains the largest portion of the pie will be declared the winner.
- 10. If the portions are too close to determine a winner, the prize money will be split equally between the shared square holders.
- 11. If the cow drops on the intersection of four squares, the cash prize will be split four ways evenly among the four owners.
- 12. Plop prize winner will receive 50% of ticket sales.
- 13. If the cow pie lands on a square that is unsold, the winner will be the closest "sold" square or squares immediately adjacent to and sharing at least one full side with the unnumbered, unsold square. This could end up being more than one winner (up to, but not to exceed, 4 winners) who would share in the prize money equally.
- 14. Judges will be present during the event to determine the winner. The decision of the officials is final.
- 15. The winning square and owner's name will be announced at the end of the game. Winner DOES NOT need to be present to win, but upon notification via phone and/or by email, the winner has 30 days to claim the prize or it will be considered a donation to the Young Farmers & Ranchers Committee.
- 16. Event will be held rain or shine. In the event of severe weather, a drawing will be held to determine the winner.
